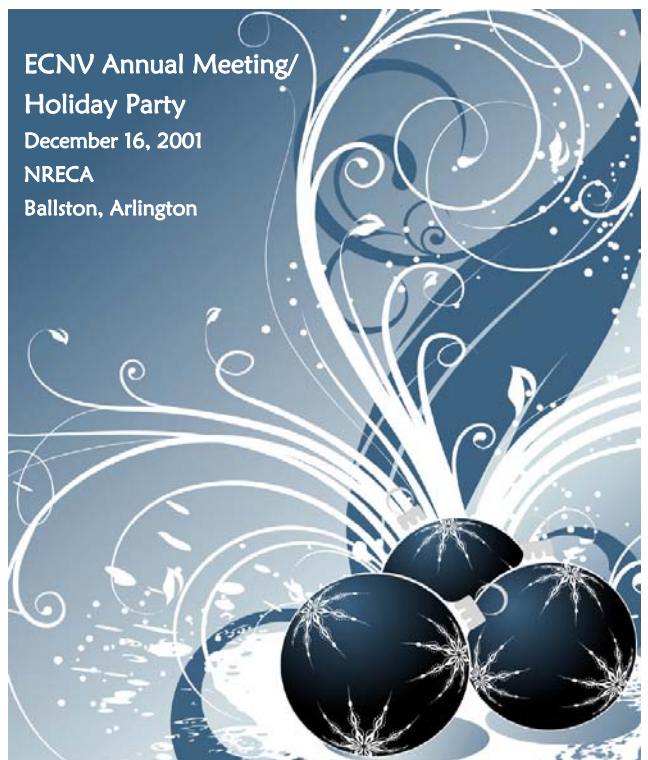

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I would like thank everyone who has contributed in any way to ECVN in 2011.

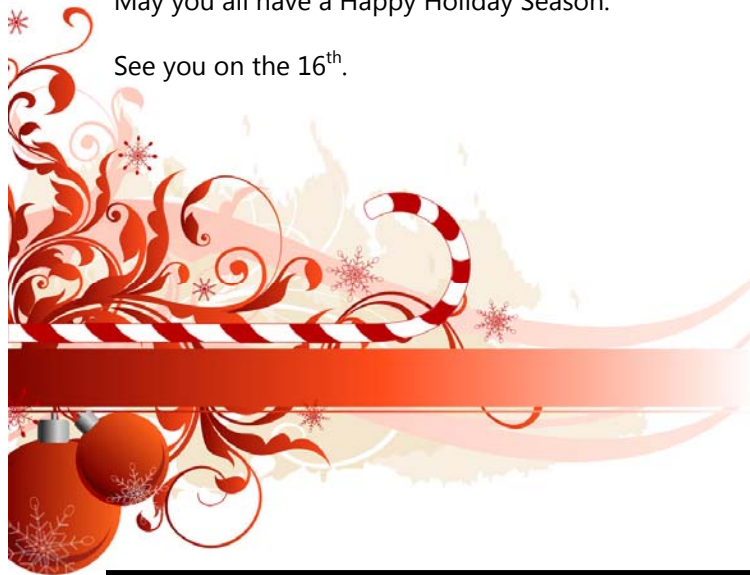
